

VANCOUVER ISLAND SUMMER SCOUT CAMP CAMP RULES

The Vancouver Island Scout Summer Camp is all about fun, spending time with friends and making new ones, and using the skills and experiences that Scouting has to offer. To ensure that all campers, counsellors and staff have an enjoyable and safe experience, we ask that all attendees observe the following rules.

1. The Scouter Staff area is out of bounds for all scouts.
2. During water activities there is to be no horseplay, including: pushing people off the dock, holding another scout while in the water or any other activity that may cause injury or discomfort to another.
3. All scouts must stay within the camp boundaries at all times unless permission is granted by the Camp Chief or designate.
4. Lights out and quiet time is 11.00pm.
5. No fraternization between campers will be allowed.
6. No scout is allowed to enter a tent that is not theirs- without exception.
7. No scout is allowed to have anyone else's personal equipment unless they have the permission of the owner.
8. Scouts are not to trade possessions.
9. Swearing and foul language will not be tolerated. We operate a three strike system, starting with a warning to the scout, followed by a phone call home to the parent/guardian and finally the parent/guardian will be called to collect the scout from camp.
10. Bullying will not be tolerated and the offending scout may be sent home.
11. Absolutely no drugs (other than medically prescribed) or alcohol will be permitted on site.

We would ask that both the parent and scout review and sign to acknowledge an understanding of these rules. Every camper deserves to have an enjoyable and safe time at Camp. By signing this document, both parent and scout agree to be bound by the Camp Rules.
